As you will now be aware, Bromley Council have suggested that we might be able to use Havelock Recreation Ground to build a brand new school for us to move into in September 2016.

The next steps are for the Council to consult local residents and apply for planning permission.

Our plans for a new building within Havelock Recreation Ground would include:

- 21st century school – digital, eco and modern
- Outdoor facilities for the children
- Outdoor facilities for members of the public
- Outdoor gym, sports field and track
- Nature area (e.g. wildflower meadow, etc.)
- A local café and bakery!

Our aim would be to work very closely with the local community to ensure that Havelock Recreation Ground – which is currently void of facilities for families to use – is improved for the benefit of everyone.
