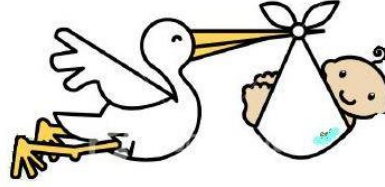

In terms of our temporary site, we can now announce that Trinity Church of England Primary School have kindly agree to let us use the whole building where we currently are. This means that a few extra rooms will be made available to us this summer for our school to expand.

School Summer Hats: children should wear their own hats during hot weather (labelled with your child's name).

Sun Cream: As per school policy, and to follow health and safety guidelines, *'parents are reminded that children should have sun cream applied at home before school, as staff cannot apply it. Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 children may bring sun cream to put on themselves at playtime/lunchtime, though they may not share this with others (bottles need to be clearly*

labelled with the children's names).' (Adverse Weather Conditions Policy – JUNE 2014)

For Reception children, we will guide the children on how to apply their own sun cream, but we are unable to do it for them. Your support in teaching them to apply sun cream independently is therefore greatly appreciated.

FRENCH LEARNING




A big **MERCI** to those parents and friends who attended our French Coffee Morning last Friday. It was great to see many of you!
