Building on the great success of our first Board Games evening, a few weeks ago, we're already looking forward to our next one!

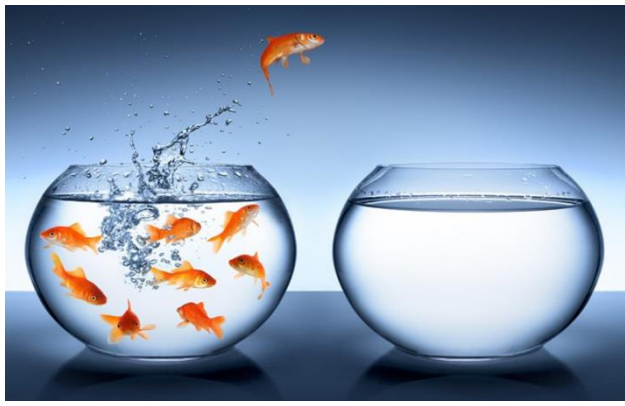
- 🕒 When: Tuesday 12th February, 17:00-18:30
