Please, note that the Office hours are 08:00-16:00. After 16:00, please leave a message on the answerphone and we will respond to your query the following day.

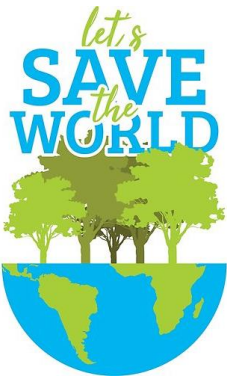
To let after-school clubs know that you are running late to collect, please call Club Leaders directly and leave a message. Their details are available on the Club Timetable we share termly.
