### FOLLOW-UP FROM PTA OPEN MEETING ON 3<sup>RD</sup> MAY

Thank you to those parents who joined us just over a week ago for our PTA Q&A session! Bringing in new ideas, volunteers and momentum is a real priority for us in order to deliver on our mission of fundraising and community building for the children of La Fontaine Academy.

It was really helpful for us to get your perspectives and ideas, which were much appreciated and are inspiring our next steps. These include:

\* Building our PTA presence - through updates on ClassList, here in the newsletter, through a new larger notice board in the playground (with aspirations for digital notice board in future), through increased presence in the playground during summer term (look out for our PTA information stands) and through some video shorts that explain more about our key projects and the variety of ways you can help with the PTA and their associated time commitment.

\* Creating more transparency around our goals / fundraising targets / where we need help and ideas - we've heard that many parents and carers may not know enough about our aims, progress, successes and areas where help is needed. We want this to change, *but need more volunteers to make this happen*. In future, we aim to:

- Explore posting school wish lists on ClassList so parents and carers can make a donation to a specific project
- Approach the 2019/20 school year with a fundraising goal matched to particular projects, and will then communicate progress to the school community more regularly

\* Holding an open PTA evening meeting to see if this proves a welcome forum for parents and carers unable to attend meetings during school hours

\* Developing key project committees to take forward larger projects.

\* Recruiting volunteers for a range of roles throughout the school year - from volunteers for our events committee to one off community relationship managers, we have a list of ways you can help and will be sharing it on ClassList and in the playground. If you are interested in helping in any way, contact our Chair, Leah Harley-Taplin, on ClassList and let us know how you'd like to become involved.
