## SITE UPDATES

Thank you to the many parents/carers who took the time to attend our Coffee Morning on Friday. As promised, we shared a few updates about our site and, as also discussed, here is a summary of what is going to happen over the coming days/weeks. We thank you, as every for your continued support and cooperation, especially as we are looking forward to a finished site!

1) On Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June, the following classrooms are being move to the Civitas Wing of our building (Block B):

- Year 1 – Simone de Beauvoir
- Year 2 – Haroun Tazieff

- Year 4 – Michel Roux Junior
- Year 5 – Simone Veil

In addition, we are relocating our current library (into its permanent location – currently Year 1 SdB), our staff room, our Assistant Headteacher's office, our SENDco's office, our PTA's storage area, and a couple of group rooms.

Thank you to those parents/carers who are helping on Wednesday/Thursday this week, from 16:30-19:00, as we are packing our library books and the equipment stored in our group rooms. Your support is hugely appreciated!

2) From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June, Kier will begin to do some pre-demolition work to eventually demolish the back end of the Invicta Wing (Block A). starting now means that they will be able to start building our playground sooner rather than later. Starting now means that the delivery of the playground should remain on track for October half-term (so Kier tell me).

3) From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June – and to allow Kier to begin to do some pre-demolition work – our playground will become inaccessible. Instead, we will be using the field for our playtimes. **Please, ensure that children bring a pair of trainers that they could keep at school, to make their use of the field even more enjoyable.** Please, start bringing pairs of trainers now (clearly labelled).

4) From Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June, drop off in the morning and pick up in the afternoon will happen in our sports hall. The entrance will be clearly indicated and staff will be available on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June to show parents/carers where to go. Whilst the location will be different, logistics will remain the same (e.g. prams, etc. can still be used).

5) Kitchen closure: we are hoping that our new kitchen will be operational as planned (Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> June). Should it be slightly delayed, we will let you know as soon as possible.

6) Drop off and Pick up for Energy Kidz will be via Nightingale Lane (up the stairs leading to our new hall). Please, check arrangements before Monday. Parking on Nightingale Lane before 08:15 and after 16:30 is usually easy.

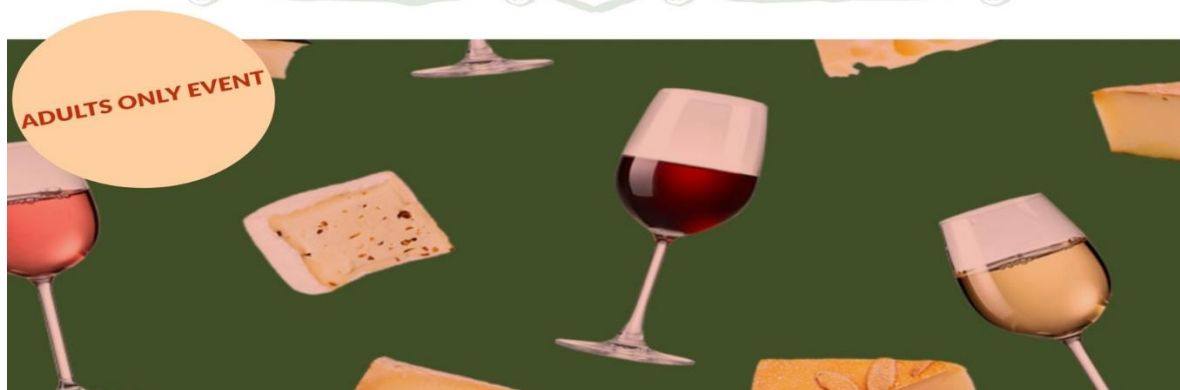
