NEW LOGISTICS – REMINDERS

- 💡 Drop off in the Sports Hall from 08:15. Children making their way to school on their own (Year 6) should not arrive before 08:15, as access to the hall will be restricted.
- 💡 Please, ensure that children do not run/cycle/scoot in the Sports Hall. No staff are there until 08:25, so children need to be supervised.
- 💡 Energy Kidz: Drop off and pick up from the Energy Kidz entrance on Nightingale Lane.
- 💡 Clubs: children will be dropped off in the Sports Hall at 16:30.
- 💡 Lunches: our kitchen will soon be operational. Packed lunches until Friday 28th June.
- 💡 Lost property: the lost property box is placed outside the sports hall. It'll be emptied very Friday, and clothes will be donated to charity.



PUNCTUALITY IS KEY!

We are writing to all children's families to emphasise the importance of being in school on time as there have been numerous incidents of some families routinely arriving at school after 08:30.

From Monday 24th June, it is vital your child(ren) arrive on time. Madame Hazzard may not be in a position to leave the school office to take your child(ren) to their new classrooms, so please make sure they are dropped off at the new drop-off point on time every morning.

We must stress, that children who arrive late are greatly disadvantaged because they miss starting the day with their peers and the beginning of lessons. This means that they are often unsettled and confused about tasks.

It is also very important that children establish good routines and habits in preparation for the rest of their lives. Punctuality is a life skill that they need to develop whilst they are young.
